OVERVIEW	<p>Haemonetics is a global leader in blood processing technology. The Company's technologies are used with surgical patients and blood donors. The Patient devices are used during surgery to collect the blood lost by a patient, clean that blood, and make it available for transfusion back to the patient. The Donor devices are used during blood donations to automate the collection and processing of blood that is required to make it transfusable to a patient or ready for fractionation and manufacture into pharmaceuticals.</p> <p>Blood is needed for a variety of patients, including cancer patients, accident victims and those undergoing surgeries, but out of the millions of Americans who are eligible to donate blood, only five percent donate. With a shrinking blood supply, hospitals and blood banks run the risk of not having enough blood in the event of a crisis. Automated blood processing technology can help increase blood supplies and make blood available for those patients that need it.</p>
