Mark Popovsky, M.D., Vice President, Corporate Medical Director

Dr. Mark Popovsky's expertise includes extensive experience in anatomic and clinical pathology and transfusion medicine. Prior to joining Haemonetics, Dr. Popovsky was chief executive officer and chief medical officer in the New England region for the American Red Cross. He previously held the position of medical director of the American Red Cross New England Region from 1985-1996. Dr. Popovsky also served as director of transfusion and intravenous services at the Mayo Clinic from 1981-1985, where he received his training in anatomic and clinical pathology.

Dr. Popovsky currently is clinical professor of laboratory medicine at Boston University Medical School and associate clinical professor of pathology at Harvard Medical School and Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston. He has authored, or co-authored, over 250 publications in transfusion medicine. Dr. Popovsky serves on the editorial board of five journals.

Dr. Popovsky holds a doctorate from the University of Vermont College of Medicine.
